






## Tip by Dick Raczuk "Koul Tools"

Shop Helper (no, not the dog)

Enclosed photo of a devise I assembled several years ago. It really comes in handy when you need someone to hold something in place while you drill; weld or you are just doing a check fit. Problem is, that someone may not be around to help. To make this tool, you simply need a base, an adjustable column, and a swivel tool. On top of the adjustable column, I mounted the swivel tool, and then attached a small vise to it. This gives you variable positions to set the vise too. The vise is the helping hand. It goes up, down and all around.

I used this to hold my fenders in place while working on the Hollywood. It really comes in handy and doesn't take breaks.


