Summer Heat and H₂O

Why water is so important when the heat increases.

1. Water helps to regulate your body temperature.
2. Water helps our cells, muscles, joints, organs, skin, and brain perform optimally.
3. Proper water intake helps to regulate a proper blood pressure.
4. Proper water intake can help short term memory.
5. Proper water intake aids in proper digestion

Signs you're not getting enough water

1. Trouble with your memory
2. Dry mouth
3. Muscle cramps

5. Constipation
6. Dark urine
7. Excessive thirst

Water recommendations

A good goal to shoot for is 8 glasses with 8 ounces of water. This is easy to remember as well as to track throughout the day.

Here are the requirements of water intake for men and women by The National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine.

1. Men: 15.5 cups or 137 liters per day.
2. Women: 11.5 cups or 127 liters per day.

The LA Roadster show went back to the old format put on by the club members. 100's of Roadsters, the swap meet was full and there were 7 rows of cars in the Specialty Car parking area!! All the vendors were outside, no event buildings this year plus almost all the vendors were car related. I like the new old format and enjoyed the show better than last years. Saw a number of club members and others from Lake Havasu.

We have a number of the club members, which have amazing talent. One of them is Ed Coyer who often helps Dick Raczuk with projects. Ed is in the process of building/restoring a 1955 Nomad. He does all his own work and has modified/modernized the chassis and drive train but will keep the original appearance of the outside and interior. Modifications include a Chevy computerized LS3 engine, and 4L65 electric transmission and a Strange tru-trac Chevy 12 Bolt reared and Wilwood disc brakes on all four corners. Chassis mods include A-Arms, Dropped Spindles, Sway bar and Coil-over Shocks. Although the stock Chevy Body was in very good shape the normal Nomad rust areas near the floor in the tailgate area prompted Ed to completely replace the floor in the car. Other additions include Air conditioning, and cruise control. After completion of the chassis and floor work Ed reassembled the car and drove it around for several months looking for any tweaks that were needed. Next was painting and finishing off the chassis. Followed by gap repair/adjustments to the body. Ed waited for warmer weather to cover the entire car in SPI epoxy primer before doing the bodywork. Ed also makes his own tools like a steel frame to hold the body in place while he replaced the floor. He also made guides that contoured to curves in the body as he does the body work and skim coat. Other small but cool deals we're making the original shifter work with the electronic 4L65 transmission and the stock gas peddle control the wireless throttle. Ed is now in the multi step body preparation. Once he finishes he will reassemble the car to check the bodywork and gaps before disassembling the entire car for paint. Ed will have the car professionally painted.

Tip by Dick Raczuk "Koul Tools"

SAFETY FIRST::

If you are lucky enough to own a lift, please use the following tip to save your feet from getting crushed. I use this when the lift is off the stops toward the bottom and there is nothing to stop it from going all the way to the floor. You may be working on your engine and need to get it little bit lower to reach something. So you lower the lift and it's not on the stops anymore. That's when you need to slide a couple pieces of wood under arms to prevent them from crushing your feet if something popped or the valve let loose. It only takes a minute when you stack them someplace close. (next to lift)

Remember, you will lose a lot of work time if you crush your feet.




