



# "Shop Tip" by Dick Raczuk

Friendly reminder .... It's easy to forget the maintenance on your street rod these days. Even if you do remember, by the time you get ready for it, you forgot where the grease gun is. Yes, old cars have grease joints unlike new cars. It's really a good idea to keep track of your maintenance for your rod, especially if you have more than one. Here is a lot of things to check. (I think)

- 1. oil generator
- 2. grease all joints
- 3. check mileage for oil and filter change (I write the mileage on the filter)
- 4. check tire pressure and age
- 5. check coolant level
- 6. during the summer, carry an umbrella for sunshade
- 7. Front wheel bearings grease
- 8. AC tune up if you have one
- 9. check fan belts
- 10. check trans levels
- 11. write the mileage down on a piece of tape and place it where you will see it as a reminder.
- PS: I just remembered I forgot some of these!!!!!!
