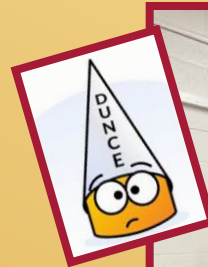


Toilet Seat award

Dan Moio won the 50/50 drawing (\$42) at the club meeting

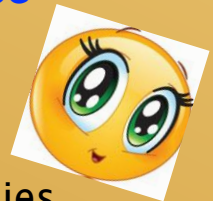


Dumb Shit Award

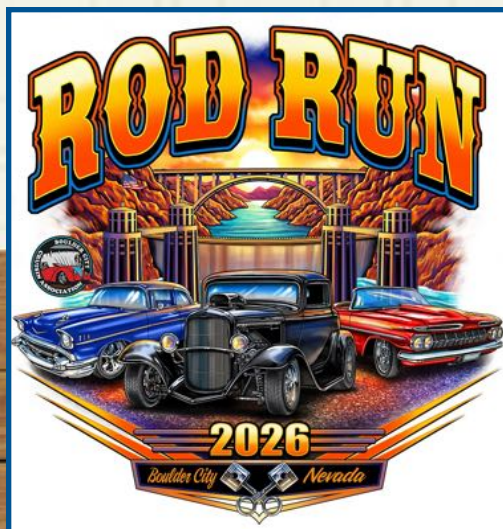

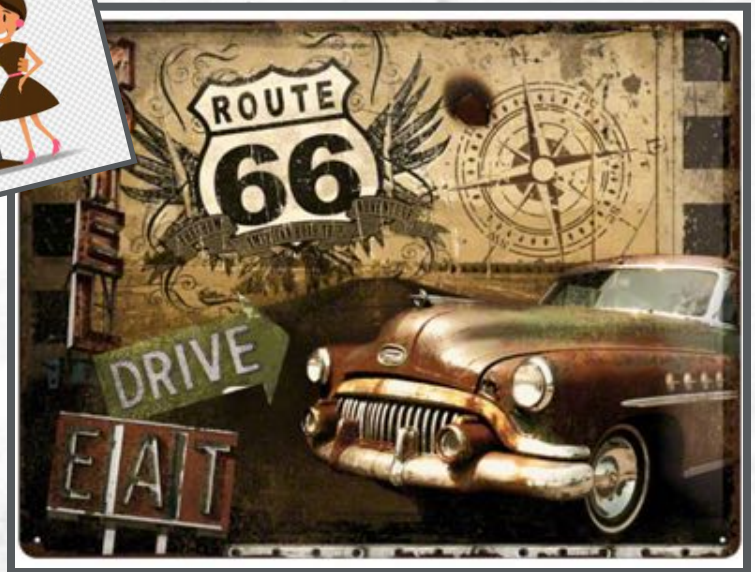

When not to use thread seal tape

You should not use thread tape (Teflon tape) on connections with built-in rubber gaskets, O-rings, or seals (like garden hoses, toilets, or compression fittings), as the tape prevents proper compression and causes leaks; also avoid it on flare fittings, fuel/gas lines (can clog), and glued PVC/PEX connections, where the seal is made by other means.

Tape should only go on tapered pipe threads (NPT/BSPT) where the threads themselves create the seal. And then just keep wrapping it around in the same direction as the threads (.9 clockwise) Until you did three more
